Terms and Conditions of Entry

These Terms and Conditions of Entry ("Entry Terms") are designed to enable the Tour de Mo on Saturday 30 November 2019 (the "Event") to run smoothly and safely. By registering to participate in the Event, you (the "Rider") accept and agree to be bound by these Entry Terms.

Entry Requirements

1.0 The Rider may elect to take part in the Event, a 203km ride starting on the Central Plateau (north of Pine Lake) and finishing at Hobart (N.B. the ride length may not be exactly this distance).

2.0 A registration is not considered to be complete, and a place will not be held in the ride, until the Rider has joined the Moustache Riders Movember Team <https://moteam.co/moustache-riders>, all the required rider information is supplied, and payment in full has been received.

3.0 The Rider warrants that he/she has prior experience or will obtain experience riding in groups to enable them to ride safely within the peloton.

4.0 The Rider must be aged 18 years or older on the day of the Event.

5.0 The Rider agrees to raise money for Movember and prior to the Event join the Moustache Riders Movember Team <https://moteam.co/moustache-riders>

6.0 The Moustache Riders Inc may, in its absolute discretion and without giving reasons for its decision, accept or refuse an application for registration.

Cancellations

7.0 If the Rider wishes to cancel his/her participation in the Event, the Rider must notify Moustache Riders Inc by email - mobart.moriders@gmail.com.

8.0 Written cancellations received before 5pm 26 August 2019 (AEST) will be refunded 80% of their entry fee.

9.0 No refunds will be offered for cancellations received after 5pm 26 August 2019 (AEST).

10.0 Except as otherwise stated in these Entry Terms and as required by law, Moustache Riders Inc is under no obligation to refund monies or entry fees due to non-use, cancellation, failure to participate or dissatisfaction by the Rider.

Transfers

11.0 The Rider may transfer his/her registration for the Event on the condition that the kit they have is suitable for the proposed replacement rider and the Rider:

- emails the Moustache Riders Inc to advise them of the transfer; and

- has the replacement Rider fill out an entry form, and the entry is accepted.

Transfers will not be offered after 5pm 07 November 2019 (AEST).

Ride communications

12.0 Ride communications will principally be made via email. The Rider should therefore provide a valid email address. Event information will also be made available on www.moustacheriders.com and via social media.

13.0 The Rider consents to receiving and reading all information that is made available on the Moustache Riders Inc website, in email newsletters, the Ride Guide and all other literature concerning the Event.

Mode of Transport

14.0 Only standard, human-powered bicycles are permitted on the Event. Unicycles, mountain bikes, scooters, motorised and power-assisted bicycles, recumbents, child seats, tagalongs, trailers and animals are not permitted on the Event.

Sag Wagon

15.0 Sag Wagons will be operating for the duration of the Event, to support Riders who have a mechanical break-down or are unable to continue riding to exhaustion, injury or fatigue.

16.0 Moustache Riders Inc will use its best endeavours to take due care in handling bicycles and or accessories on the Sag Wagon, but is not responsible for any loss, damage, cost or expense that the Rider may suffer or incur as a result of Moustache Riders Inc handling his/her bike and or accessories.

Closing Dates for Entries

17.0 All Event entries close at 10pm Sunday 18 August 2019 unless sold out prior.

Acknowledgment and Waiver

18.0 The Rider acknowledges and agrees that participation in the Event is inherently dangerous and that he/she participates in the Event at his/her own risk.

19.0 In consideration of Moustache Riders Inc permitting the Rider to enter and participate in the Event, the Rider hereby releases and indemnifies Moustache Riders Inc, affiliates, the sponsors of the Event and any respective representatives from and against all and any claims, law suits, demands, liabilities, loss and damage (including indirect and consequential loss), costs, expenses and, interest, whether pursuant to common law or statute, that the Rider may suffer or incur arising from or connected with the Rider's participation in the Ride including as a result of the negligence, breach of duty, breach of care or other fault or responsibility of Moustache Rider Inc, the sponsors of the Event and any of their respective representatives.

Compliance with Laws and Regulations

20.0 During the Event, the Rider must comply with all traffic and road laws and regulations, all directions issued by Tasmania Police and all instructions given by Moustache Riders Inc or any board members or officials representing Moustache Riders Inc at the Event. Failure to do so may result in the Rider being removed from the Event and will not receive a registration refund.

21.0 The Rider must wear an Australian standard cycling helmet at all times during the Event while riding a bicycle.

Compulsory Equipment and Clothing

22.0 Riders must ensure that their bike, equipment and clothing are suitable for the nature of road riding undertaken and alpine terrain travelled through during the Event.

23.0 Riders must ensure that their bike is in excellent working order with consideration given to appropriate gearing, chain condition, saddle comfort, wheels, spokes and tyre condition and brakes efficiency.

24.0 All Riders must wear or have available the following equipment and clothing for the duration of the Event:

- Bike helmet as specified in Clause 21.0;
- Bike lights for dark, wet, foggy or low visibility conditions; spare light batteries (if your light requires them);
- Rain jacket, warmers etc (clearly labelled rider bag can be placed in Sag Wagon that can be accessed at rest stops);
- 2 x drink bottles;
- Puncture repair kit and tubes
- Inflation device
- Secondary food supplies (clearly labelled rider bag can be placed in Sag Wagon that can be accessed at rest stops).

Safe Cycling and Rider Etiquette

25.0 The Tour de Mo is a group ride not a race. All participants must be; competent bike riders, trained for the Event and be familiar with riding on public roads.

26.0 Riders must not take any risks that could put themselves or other riders and road users in a dangerous situation.

27.0 The following requirement will assist riders to complete the ride safely and incident free:

- When descending; ride within your limits, do not take any risks and keep left at all times
- Do not overtake the lead Marshal at any time (this includes during descents)
- If you are behind another rider, ensure your hands have access to the brakes (ie hands on ramps, hoods or drops - not on tops or tri-bars)
- On descents if you are overtaking another rider, do not exceed the speed of the rider you are passing by more than 10km/h
- Ride to the left side of the left lane
- Do not cross the white line in the centre of the road
- Do not ride on the wrong side of the road
- Do not overtake other riders on their left
- No overtaking on descending corners
- Use a hand signal if turning
- Use hand and voice signals when changing or altering the current course of your direction or moving state
- Do not ride more than two abreast, no more than 1.5 m apart, unless overtaking other riders (when safe to do so)
- Keep left unless overtaking
- Obey all road rules, traffic signals, and signs
- Obey all safety instructions and directions provided by Moustache Riders Inc and the Marshals
- Do not litter along the route - dispose of all rubbish at bins located at rest stops

Preparation, Training, Health and Safety

28.0 The Rider is responsible for ensuring that he/she has adequately and appropriately prepared both physically and mentally for the Event. If the Rider has any health issues or doubts prior to the Event, he/she should immediately seek appropriate medical advice.

29.0 If, during the Event, the Rider becomes ill or is injured, Moustache Riders Inc will endeavour to arrange medical transport, usually in an ambulance. Any medical transport will be at the Rider's expense. Moustache Riders Inc recommends that Riders hold current health insurance to cover such costs.

Common Sense

30.0 The Rider must ride in a safe and responsible manner during the Event and use common sense at all times.

31.0 The Rider must exercise caution on all public roads and other thoroughfares and ride defensively and courteously.

Meals and Dietary Requirements

32.0 Moustache Riders Inc will offer hydration and some snacks at rest stops. Riders must supply their own supplementary nutrition.

33.0 Moustache Riders Inc and their sponsors cannot however, guarantee that any meal or food item is exactly as described - contamination by allergens can occur that is beyond Moustache Riders Inc and/or the sponsor's reasonable control.

34.0 It is solely the Rider's responsibility to carry on you at all times, suitable food and/or medication which may be necessary to treat any particular medical condition that you suffer from. A clearly labelled rider bag may be placed in Sag Wagon that can be accessed at rest stops to assist Riders in food distribution along the route.

Ride and Ride Option Variation

35.0 Moustache Riders Inc reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, to:

- A) change or vary the route of any of the Event without notice;
- B) cancel, postpone, reschedule or change the time or place for the Event for any reason and at any time prior to the commencement of the Event; and
- C) Moustache Riders Inc is not responsible for or liable to the Rider for any loss, damage, cost or expense, whether direct, indirect, consequential or otherwise incurred by the Rider resulting from any such action taken by Moustache Riders Inc.

Riders' Capacity to Remain With the Peloton

36.0 Riders must follow Event Marshall directions in circumstance where they are failing to remain with the Peloton, which may include an instruction to travel in the Sag Bus.

37.0 Should a Rider refuse to obey directions by an Event Marshall the Rider will be removed from the Event and unsupported in their return to the finish site.

Private Support Vehicles

38.0 Private support vehicles are asked to minimise following directly behind the peloton to avoid traffic congestion. Supporters are asked to meet the Peloton at rest stop and depart the stop prior to the Peloton.

39.0 If a Rider retires from the Event, friends or family can collect the Rider by accessing the rider route. Alternatively the Rider may travel on the Sag Bus.

Photography

40.0 The Rider acknowledges and agrees that he/she may be photographed or filmed during the Event and consents to Moustache Riders Inc using the Rider's picture and likeness contained in any photographs or film for publicising the Event and for promoting any future ride or Event to be staged by Moustache Riders Inc.

41.0 Participants in the Event, give their permission to have their details forwarded to the media who may cover the Event.

Other

42.0 The Event will be held outdoors and may proceed notwithstanding poor weather conditions on the day of the Ride. Moustache Riders Inc is not liable to the Rider for any loss,

damage, cost or expense of any kind including, but not limited to, refund of entry fees, in the Event of poor weather before, during or if the Event is cancelled.

43.0 Moustache Riders Inc reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, to refuse to allow the Rider to participate in the Event or to remove the Rider from the Event for breach of these Entry Terms or if it otherwise determines it appropriate to do so.

44.0 Moustache Riders Inc is not liable to the Rider for any loss, damage, cost or expense of any kind, including but not limited to, the refund of the entry fee, if the Rider is denied access to or removed from the Event for any reason.

45.0 "Moustache Riders Inc" means the Moustache Riders Incorporated ABN 15714718458 and includes where appropriate Moustache Riders Inc's members, volunteers, agents, contractors and officers.

46.0 Moustache Riders Inc reserves the right to alter these terms and conditions at any time. All registered Riders who have agreed to the terms and conditions prior to these amendments will be notified and will need to agree to the updated terms and conditions.
